Guest Presenters: Susan Baugher, AACPS Human Resources, provides an overview of the upcoming changes to healthcare benefits. Open enrollment begins 10/1. There are three open enrollment meetings. No action is needed if no changes are being made. Funding for medical and dental remains at 75%. Vision is retiree funded. Medical premiums will increase by 5%. No copayment changes. Check for variations to coverage for those under 65 years of age.

Karen Straughan, Assistant District Attorney, provides an overview of potential scams that are perpetrated on senior citizens. She explains that there are two mediation units that provide free services. One is a general mediation unit the other covers health advocacy. Call for

assistance if you feel you have been scammed. Do not provide personal information to anyone either on the phone or online. Beware of the Green Dot card which is a reloadable credit card.
